are holding a meeting to celebrate

The Distinctiveness of Sampford Courtenay and the part it played in the Prayer Book Rebellion

The **morning session** will be held at the Sampford Courtenay Village Hall, Chapple Lane, Sampford Courtenay EX20 2SY **Starting at 10.30am, finishing at 13.00pm.**

The day will begin with a presentation by the History Section.

This will be followed by a visit to St Andrews Church, with presentations by Helen Wilson and Sue Andrews of the Building Section:

1. The pre-Reformation church and its decoration, including roof bosses
2. The Prayer Book Rebellion, when everything was swept away (briefly, but put in the context of other changes in the church)
3. The awful state of the church at the end of the nineteenth century, and its restoration
4. The work of the Pinwill sisters

There will then be an opportunity to view the Prayer Book Rebellion display.

The visit to Church House will include further presentations by Helen Wilson and Sue Andrews.

Starting at 2.00pm, the **afternoon session** will be held at Solland Farm, Exbourne, Okehampton, EX203QT

The visit will include a guided tour of the Cider Farm and the chance to understand more about the village and the part it played in the Prayer Book Rebellion.

Costs

The Morning Session will cost **£8.00** for **DA members** and **£10.00** for **non-members**.

The Afternoon Session will cost **£6.00** for both members and non-members.

Bookings for **both sessions** will be **£12.00 for DA members** and **£14.00 for non-members**.
