Cave tour revealing evidence of very early human life in this country. Followed by a presentation by the Cave Conservation Officer on the modern history, including the growing awareness of the caves since the 16th Century, the Victorian excavations by DA co-founder William Pengelly FRS, and current heritage conservation and public education initiatives.

DISABLED ACCESS

There are a few steep gradients of up to 1:4 – 1:5 in the caves, with nine shallow steps and some narrow sections, unfortunately wheelchairs cannot negotiate past the first chamber of the cave. A DVD of the cave tour can be viewed in the visitor centre free of charge.
